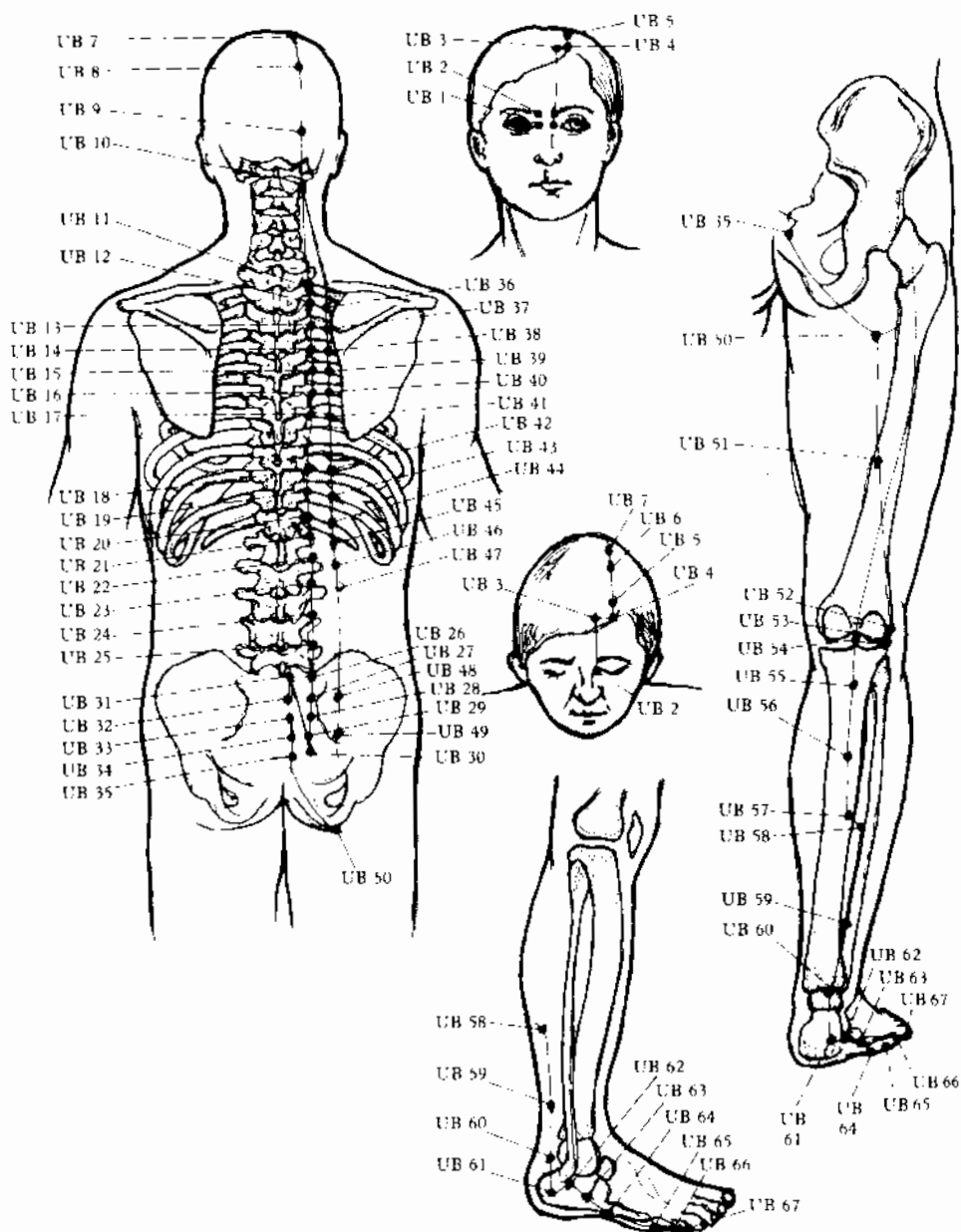


Figure 2-8. Meridian UB [Urinary Bladder, Tsu Tai Yang Pang Kuang Ching, Foot-Taiyang, G]

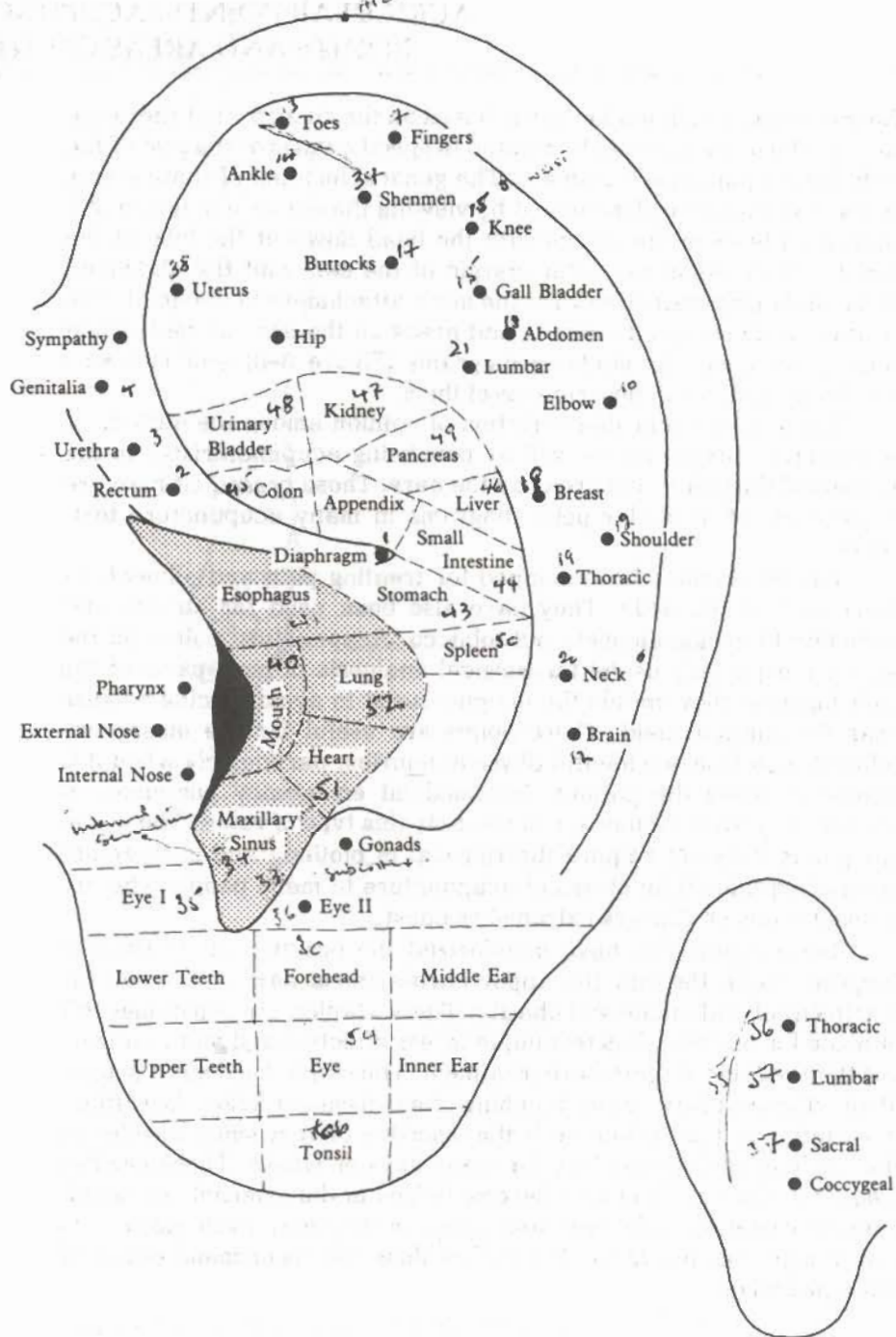


Figure 3-8. Auricular points

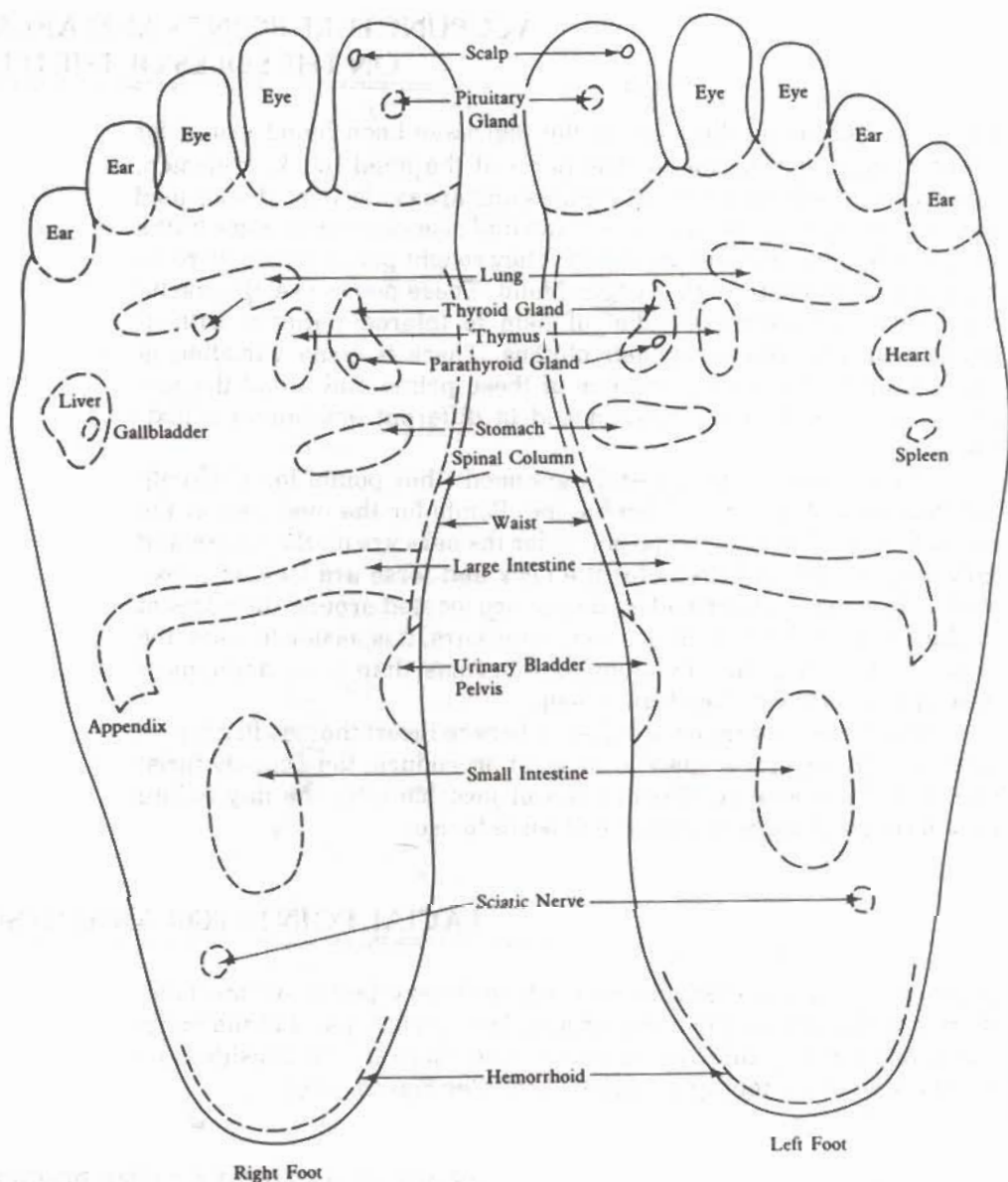


Figure 3-9. Acupuncture points and areas on the soles of the feet
